"THE FAMILY: CALLED TO RADIATE THE JOY OF LOVE" Leonora Butau, Ph.D., Program Director, St. John Paul II Foundation

Catholic families are called to be fountains of living water in a world thirsting for God. The family is a place where the Gospel is shared and from which the joy of God's love is radiated to others. In responding to the call to love one another as Christ loves us, married couples and families must first draw strength from God, especially in His Eucharistic presence, and allow Him to fill them with His love. In this way, they become authentic witnesses of the power and joy of their own personal encounter with this same love. In this talk, Dr. Butau will discuss the family as an evangelizing community; a community where each member is called to draw strength from God and from His love "poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit" (Romans 5: 5), making us capable of loving our spouse, our children, those around us, and even strangers, with Christ's love, and to see them through His merciful eyes.

No doubt, even the happiest family is not perfect, and we must avoid unhealthy comparisons. Yet, the Church makes available to us through the closely linked Sacraments of Matrimony and of the Eucharist the grace to start - today - to enter more deeply into the joy of Our Lord, Jesus Christ. In this talk, Mr. Nichols will present these basic ideas of the Church in an accessible way, pointing to practical ways that spouses at any point in their spiritual journey can bring each other, their family, and their community closer to Jesus—growing in joy and peace along the way.
