“The Church thus finds in the family, born from the sacrament, the cradle and the setting in which she can enter the human generations.” – Pope John Paul II. We know that the final battle between the Lord and the kingdom of Satan will be about Marriage and the Family. We do not need to be afraid, and rather strive to know ever more deeply who we are, whose we are, and live that ever more boldly in the world.
