St. John Paul famously said that "the future of evangelization depends in great part on the Church of the home." As a domestic church, your family is called to radiate the light of Christ in a darkened world. The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph was the way that God chose to enter into the world to redeem it. As the heart of the Holy Family, Mary was the first disciple of her Son, Jesus. She was also the first evangelizer, bringing Jesus to her cousin Elizabeth. In this talk, couples will learn from Mary how to welcome Christ into their homes and then bear him forth to others in the ordinary circumstances of family life.
