




What is the At-Home Conference Experience?

Why the At-Home Conference Experience?

The At-Home Conference Experience will be offered exclusively for this year's event, and is designed to enable couples to participate in the *Together in Holiness* conference from within their own domestic church. While nothing can replace the communal element of the conference or the participation in the sacraments, we hope this option will serve as a reminder to couples and families that their response to the universal call to holiness begins at home.

We recognize this pandemic has stretched couples and families, so now more than ever it is important to refocus and rejuvenate your marriage and family life. This experience provides an opportunity to prioritize prayerful, intentional time with your spouse, while also providing practical tools for cultivating a Domestic Church in your home.

What is the cost?

At-Home tickets are \$15.
This price supports our speakers and helps cover costs such as travel, printed materials, and postage.

If you need assistance with the cost of the conference, we encourage you to apply for a partial or full scholarship; if you feel called to contribute to our scholarship fund, you can do so at the time of registration.

How does it work?

What is included in the At-Home Conference Experience?
