Health + Safety Guidelines

The St. John Paul II Foundation and our presenting sponsors remain confident that *Converging Roads* will take place in person as planned under the guidance of local and state recommendations. At this time, our health and safety guidelines for in-person attendance is as follows*:

- In-person attendance will be limited to 100 persons
- Masks are required for all conference attendees inside the venue, except when actively eating or drinking
- In-person attendees will be required to complete a COVID-19 screening and temperature check upon arriving at the conference
- Attendees registered in person will be asked to participate online if they are running a fever or experiencing other COVID-19 symptoms
- Hand sanitizer will be available at all entrances and exits
- Social distancing will be maintained when seated in the conference venue
- Check-in will be offered with minimal cross-contact
- Boxed lunches will be offered to reduce contact at meal times
