EDUCATING IN CHRIST: PARENTS AS PRIMARY TEACHERS OF THEIR CHILDREN IN THE FAITH Ryan Hanning, PhD, Fellow, San Juan Diego Institute

The Church has consistently taught that parents are the "primary educators" of their children. This foundational presentation will explore the unique mission entrusted to parents to serve as the first teachers of the faith within the domestic church. This talk will emphasize the essential role of parents in rooting their children in the teaching of the Church, the life of virtue, and regular participation in the sacraments.

What happens if I go *all-in* as a believer and disciple of Jesus Christ? Is it even necessary or possible "to be made worthy of the promises of Christ?" It's unfair, but easier, to judge the truth of the Faith by the witness of Christians who betray, fail, or compromise. It seems more just, but harder, to judge by the heroic witness of those who live it to the full. These are the saints. Ordinary men, women, and children made holy by God through their heroic faith in Him and His Church. *Their witness is for us.* This presentation will offer couples insights on how to develop a vibrant relationship with these saints.
