SACRIFICIAL LOVE IS SANCTIFYING LOVE

Married life is a school of sacrifice, self-denial, and charity, reflecting Christ's love for the Church. This presentation will discuss how striving to love each other with a pure, sacrificial love produces fruits of joy and peace within a marriage.
