EUCHARISTIC SAINTS, FAMILIES, AND EVANGELIZATION

What happens if I go all-in as a believer and disciple of Jesus Christ? Is it even necessary or possible "to be made worthy of the promises of Christ"? It's unfair, but easier, to judge the truth of the Faith by the witness of Christians who betray, fail, or compromise. It seems more just, but harder, to judge by the heroic witness of those who live it to the full. These are the saints: ordinary men, women, and children made holy by God through their heroic faith in Him and His Church. Their witness is for us.

This presentation will offer couples insights on how to develop a vibrant relationship with these saints and how a devotion to the Holy Eucharist can assist their families to bear witness to the gospel in the ordinary events of their lives.
