## THE EUCHARIST AS THE SOURCE AND SUMMIT OF THE PROPHETIC MISSION OF THE FAMILY Fr. Alex Pince, Parochial Vicar at Epiphany Cathedral and Director of Vocations for the Diocese of Venice

The family is called "to be a sign of unity for the world and in this way to exercise its prophetic role by bearing witness to the Kingdom and peace of Christ, towards which the whole world is journeying" (St. John Paul II, *Familiaris consortio*, 48). The Holy Eucharist is the source for communion within the Church as it brings about the unity between the faithful and Jesus Christ and the unity among the members of the Body of Christ, the Church. This talk will reflect upon the gift of the Holy Eucharist as a sign and foretaste of the unity that the family is called to proclaim through its faithful witness in the home and beyond.

# LETTING YOUR LIFE BE A VESSEL FOR THE GOSPEL Mallory Smyth, Speaker & Author, Walking with Purpose

Pope Benedict XVI eloquently said, "Being Christian is not the result of an ethical choice or a lofty idea, but the encounter with an event, a person, which gives life a new horizon and a decisive direction." She will teach on how to live out this encounter within marriage and the family. Finally, she will reflect upon how we can foster an encounter with Christ in the lives of our children and others.
