- Describe how restorative reproductive medicine seeks to cooperate with or restore the normal anatomy and physiology of the reproductive system.
- Appraise the unique approaches of Catholic health care providers in offering care for women that affirms their dignity and needs
- Explore medical care that respects ways women bring life, love, and their feminine genius.
- Describes how NaPro Technology optimizes the natural reproductive system.
- Differentiates between the use of NaPro Technology and Artificial Reproductive Technologies in their contrasting approaches to the human person and the reproductive system.
- Assess how NaPro Technology promotes fertility awareness that is consonant with the full flourishing of the patient.

- Discuss the medical options for a couple struggling with infertility.
- Describe the emotional, spiritual, and psychological suffering associated with infertility.
- Evaluate the best standards of care and support, treatment, and intervention for patients and families struggling with infertility.
