HOW TO NOURISH LOVE IN THE FAMILY Ryan Hanning, PhD, Fellow, St. John Paul II Foundation

"Thank you," "I'm sorry," "Excuse me" – Pope Francis has said these three statements are essential for marriage and family life. Gratitude is a foundation for love in family life, reconciliation heals family relationships when we inevitably fall short of love, and service becomes love in action. This presentation will draw from the popes and lived experience to reflect upon the practical wisdom in offering these three simple yet profound words for daily married life.

MARRIAGE, FAMILY, AND THE VIRTUE OF LOVE Chris and Kendra Bartlett

We all know well how our own brokenness can alienate us from frue love; it can alienate us from God, others, and even from ourselves. For those called to marriage, Christ has established your relationship with your spouse as a sacrament; for you it is the privileged road to true love, joy, and peace in Jesus Christ. But, what is true love and how do I live it? This presentation will explore the authentic definition of love in contrast with the false visions of love. There will be a particular focus on how the sacrament of marriage assists spouses to love and how married couples are called to inspire others with their mission of self-giving love.

SACRIFICIAL LOVE IS SANCTIFYING LOVE
